It has now been almost four years since Rodney joined our Church Militant family. He also works closely with Michael Voris on a number of levels, most especially balancing Vortex tapings with Michael's travels.


Trey and his lovely wife, Lindsey, arrived at CM Headquarters on March 13, 2017. It was Lindsey, actually, who sent Trey the article stating Church Militant was hiring. He received Lindsey's message while at Adoration and responded immediately. It took just 10 minutes for Trey to get a response from CM to set up a Skype interview with him, and the rest, as they say, is history!

Interesting side note: Trey had served five years in the Marines, from 2008–2013, before he began attending the University of North Texas. He graduated in December 2016 with a Political Science degree. He and Lindsey were both already employed when the opportunity for Trey to come aboard Church Militant presented itself. The added incentive for Lindsey to direct her husband towards CM was due, in part, to the residual anger she felt after having shown up to fight against the "nasty women's" march that took place in their hometown of Denton, Texas.

So incensed were the crowds that Lindsey and Trey dared hold up a banner in support of traditional marriage, that these self-proclaimed "nasty women" had no problem getting right in their faces to scream all kinds of obscenities at them the entire time.

This was a watershed moment for the young couple, one in which they, as Trey expressed it, "experienced the hatred that the Left had."

Because of this experience, even though it meant moving to a cold climate and leaving their family behind, Lindsey knew it was the right move — the only move. Out of her shell shock from being treated so despicably at that march, she said the only words she had left to say — "Trey, go work for Church Militant!"



When asked what he expected at Church Militant, Trey says, "I didn't know what to expect, but it's not radically different" than what he previously thought it might be. He adds that both Michael Voris and Christine Niles are "both great bosses and approachable" and he has a "good working relationship with both of them."

He gets along well with his colleagues, too, and finds that CM's "faith-driven atmosphere affects the professional level" of work here. It allows him to more easily say that he will do "whatever God wants him to do here."

Trey would like to learn to edit and operate cameras. He has also seen quite an improvement in his prayer life since being at Church Militant. He says, "I never would have gotten around to learning the prayers in Latin or making this time for prayer. Being here has instilled in me a much deeper habit of prayer."

For someone who was once very "casual" about praying, he knows he's come a long way in a short time with his spiritual growth. He attends the Latin Mass at St. Joseph's Oratory in Detroit and now has a 5 a.m. Adoration hour! Bravo, Trey! Thank you for your military service, and now, your spiritual service.


